5. Dr. Meddleton routinely draws blood for a drug screen. A drug screen can not test for every substance that can affect a horse's performance. The lab we use tests for the 28 most common tranquilizers, stimulants, anti-inflammatories, and pain killers. However, there are over 4000 substances that have been given to horses.

6. Be advised that there are certain undetectable treatments that are routinely used in horses to treat lameness and other diseases that can mask conditions that may show up after a horse is purchased. Examples of these include injecting joints with Hyaluronic Acid or cortisone, or systemic treatment with Adequan or Legend.
